

Tabletop Exercise for Those Involved in Chemical Incident Response or Emergency Planning

Federal laws related to the Clean Air Act and the Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act (EPCRA) require that local emergency and medical personnel develop methods and procedures to respond to releases of certain extremely hazardous substances (EHS). This tabletop exercise (TTX) provides an opportunity for participants to evaluate their emergency procedures during a simulated release of an EHS in Monroe County.



This exercise is designed to help meet local emergency and medical responder planning and training requirements per 42 CFR 116.11003(c).
